

CAMP PACKING LIST

Things to bring...

- Sunscreen
- Bath towel
- Wash cloth
- Sheets or sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Toothbrush & tooth paste
- Soap
- Shampoo
- Any other necessary toiletries
- Bug spray (at least 25% DEET is best)
- Swim suit
- Flip flops
- Comfortable shoes for hiking
- Comfortable clothes for the week
- Rain poncho or umbrella



Things that may be brought...

- Flashlight
- Stuffed animal (one only)
- Prescription medication (to be given to camp nurse)
- Spending money (not more than \$30)
- Camera and film
- Playing cards
- Chewing gum
- Snacks (in sealed packages)
- Cell phone (*Cell phones may only be used between 6:00 and 6:30 p.m. each day. Use at any other time during camp will result in the confiscation of the phone until the end of camp. Also, please be aware that cell phone service is unreliable at the camp location as it is in a rural area.*)

Things that may NOT be brought...

- ⊗ Game boys or other similar video game systems
- ⊗ Pocket knives or anything else that might be a weapon
- ⊗ Any sort of controlled substance or medication without a parent's note.

Notes:

1. Crossroads and New Hope cannot be responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal items brought by a student. Students are solely responsible for their personal belongings including cameras, jewelry, and cash.
2. Camp staff needs to be made aware of any medications the student may need to take. These will be held by a responsible adult and administered in accordance with the parent's or doctor's written instructions only.
